The CEO Roundtable saw pertinent insights and persuasive views from an eminent panel

Jeet Shah, Director & CFO, S J Logistics India Limited (Welcome Address)

Mr Jeet Shah began by describing Gujarat as India's leading logistics and cargo hub, and highlighted the salient features of its two key ports – Mundra and Kandla (Deendayal). He emphasised that the state is a powerhouse of business and a primary region driving the country's ex-im trade, with excellent connectivity to especially Central and North India. He also appreciated the resumption of liner shipping services through the Red Sea and Suez Canal.



Mukesh Oza, Group President & CEO, Samsara Group (Guest of Honour virtually delivering Keynote Address)

Mr Mukesh Oza emphasised that Gujarat stands tall as India's maritime and logistics backbone, which is not incidental but the result of decades of vision, sustained investment, policy support and a strategic emphasis on connectivity, efficiency and industrialisation. He highlighted Gujarat's port infrastructure as massive, diversified and globally competitive, and its integrated logistics connectivity that has created an efficient, end-to-end trade corridor from hinterland factories to international markets. The state has systematically tied ports to industrial clusters, urban centres and logistics hubs, creating seamless movement of goods and massive supply chain efficiencies. He also highlighted Gujarat's expansive development plans in ports, logistics, connectivity and other infrastructure, including a proposed large-scale port city, a maritime hub similar to Singapore or Dubai. The project includes a multi-cargo port with capacity of 250-500 million tonnes per annum and an integrated city with residential, commercial and industrial zones. Today, Gujarat is India's maritime flagship, a comprehensive integrated logistics and trade engine with the latest expansions, investments and policy momentum. It is strongly positioned to support India's export ambitions, industrial growth, global trade integration and economic transformation. It is a privilege for all of us to be stakeholders in this journey, he added.



Dilip Chudasama, Sales Director - Area India, Hapag-Lloyd India Pvt. Ltd. (Panelist)

Mr Dilip Chudasama said that the second half of 2025 was challenging for container shipping and expected 2026 too to be a testing year for carriers with the likelihood of a volatile market. There will be a lot of cost and operational focus, smart capacity moves will be made by carriers, smart cost management will be looked at, and how to better utilise assets will be considered. As regards returning to the Red Sea and Suez Canal, it will be a wait-and-watch approach before a firm decision is taken. Only when it is safe for assets, cargo and people will Hapag-Lloyd return to transiting through the Suez Canal, he said.



Devashish Patyal, Deputy CEO, INTECH Group (Panelist)

Mr Devashish Patyal emphasised that technology and digitisation have been empowering the entire spectrum of logistics, and are today not just tools for cost reduction, but can be used to optimise and scale, to obtain the best productivity, and seamlessly move the cargo. Technology is the enabler for the next generation of logistics. AI will have a disruptive impact and will enhance efficiency and productivity, he added. He also made the point that Gujarat's logistics acumen will be key for Viksit Bharat 2047.



Shanu Gupta, Director, Rishi Kiran Logistics Pvt. Ltd. (Theme Presentation)

Mr Shanu Gupta highlighted that Gujarat's four major ports and 50 plus non-major ports cater to almost 41% of India's demand, which coupled with other infrastructure like multiple ICDs/logistics parks facilitate smooth cargo handling and operations. Gujarat offers exactly what manufacturers want by connecting roads, ports and ICDs to an international market at a faster and competitive rate. Besides, Gujarat is a coastal shipping hub, home to India's first international finance city, Gift City, home to India's maiden maritime arbitration centre, enables ship leasing and purchase operations, and is soon likely to get its own shipbuilding yard, he added. Development is a constant in Gujarat, so there is a lot more coming up, be it capacity and other augmentation at ports like Mundra and Deendayal (recognised as a green hydrogen hub), new logistics and industrial facilities, and enhanced connectivity.



Avtar Singh Sohal, Chief Commercial Officer, Samsara Group

Mr Avtar Singh Sohal reiterated the Samsara Group's commitment to serving the fraternity.



Mitesh Dharamshi, General Manager - Kandla, Parekh Group (Moderator)

Mr Mitesh Dharamshi, in brief remarks, made a pertinent comment that bulk, dry bulk and break bulk cargo logistics will always be around due to some of their inherent advantages. He stressed the importance of technology adoption in the sector, to survive in business and grow to the next level. He also lauded the topical theme of the event.



Manoj Katar, COO, Adani Ports & Special Economic Zone Ltd (APSEZ) (Panelist)

Mr Manoj Katar highlighted the planned expansion of Mundra Port's container handling and other capacity in the coming years, alongside the upgrades to its rail infrastructure both inside and outside the port, equipment etc. He also made the point that there will be no shortage of cargo for the new ports coming up or planned.



Rahul Jain, CEO, Saurashtra Freight Pvt. Ltd. (Panelist)

Mr Rahul Jain highlighted that CFSs work with all stakeholders, not just ports, as customers, vendors, or even both. These include liners, CHAs, terminal operators, shippers and consignees, so there is ample scope for providing value-added services. Empty container storage, cargo storage, last mile delivery, container/cargo handling outside the CFS were mentioned. He emphasised that CFSs will continue to be relevant despite DPD and DPE, expanding their service offerings. Warehousing is today a booming business. CFSs can provide similar services. There exists huge opportunities in India, he stressed.
